The Alebuerg is a former village, and today you can still see the remains of the defensive wall. Inside this wall there used to be five houses, in which a Celtic extended family lived. At the site, you can find an information board with descriptions and photos.



B4 Local Hiking Trail in Beaufort

The B4 walking trail starts at the castle in Beaufort and takes you to the *Alebuerg*, along the *Haupeschbaach* stream and then on to the *Klingelbuer*, the old washhouse of Beaufort Castle.

Today there is a small water playground there. If you want to do the Rallye "Searching for Clues in Beaufort", the path is shortened.

1. "Holz vun hei" - Bench



Phew — that's the first bit over with. Lie back on the bench, and what can you see?

The bench is made from a tree that grew here. What types of trees are found in the region? Put a cross against the type of tree that **isn't** found here:

2. The Legend of the Ghostly Violin-Player

Short-Cut

3. Coat of Arms in the Rock

While walking on the shortcut part. Keep an eye open for a rock that looks like a coat of arms. It is located at your left. Can you find it?

What can you see on it?

4. At the Pond

This pond is a habitat for many animals and plants. Spend a bit of time here, and look out for animals. Which animal is the odd one out here?



F: Fishes B: Frogs X: Dragonflies G: Tigers

Now you are back on the marked B4 walking trail. Can you see the marker sign? Then follow it.

5. Wear Marks



On the way back to the castle, you will see plenty of rocks. Can you find the big rock with the wear marks? What made them?

6. Wash-House with Water Playground



Washing Fountain

The Klingelbuer wash-house is the former laundry of Beaufort Castle. In the past, the laundry was scrubbed and washed here. Today, you will find a small water playground with an Archimedes Screw here.

What do you need for the washing fountain and the screw to work?



There is a picnic bench in the delightful clearing here, so it's a good spot for a short stop-off.
