Mission 3


The castle used to be protected from intruders by a grid.

Mission 4

Find the kitchen on the map. In the kitchen you will see a small window where the sink used to be.

Mission 5

Look for the chapel tower on the map and go there. On the first floor there was a cozy room with a fireplace. The chimney is still on the top of the wall, but the floor has disappeared.

You can see three cups on the chimney. Which cup on the picture on the right is invented? Fill in the number.
