

"Champignon" Geosite

A little outside Nommern, you can marvel at what is probably the biggest mushroom in Luxembourg's Little Switzerland. It is not edible or poisonous, but it's all the more impressive for that: the mushroom is a block of Luxembourg sandstone. There are more sandstone blocks close to the "Champignon", on which you can spot signs of human use. The marks were made a very long time ago, when our forefathers ground their stone tools on the sandstone to sharpen them. The vegetation around these rocks is also very special.

You can walk to the "Champignon" from Nommern, on the 5.2 km N4 local walking route. But you can also drive there by car. There is a small car park at the site.

N3 Walking Trail in Nommern -**Chapel and Canyon**

The walking trail runs from the starting point in the village over a steep climb of around 1.2 km up to a forest path. At the top, the path heads left to the Lourdes Chapel with its attractive Marian statue. Beyond this, the route continues on a narrow forest path through a small canyon down towards the valley and back to your starting point.






















Actionbound: "With Noemi Noumer on the Search of Meteorite Dust"
